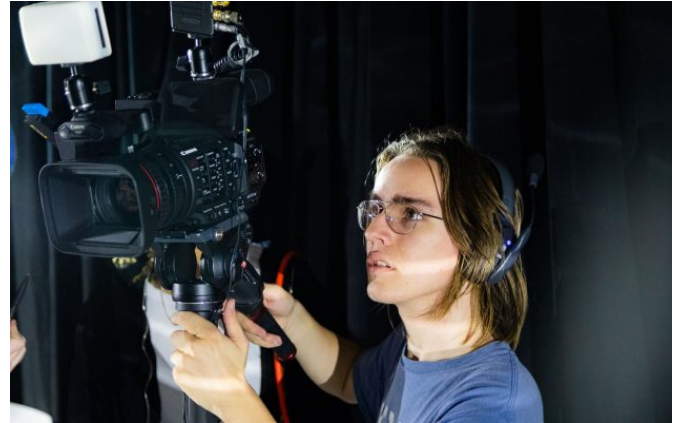


## Lights, camera, action
