**NOT ACCEPTABLE SOURCES OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

- Bank statement/letter from a business account –unless the sponsor name is listed as a named owner
- Salary statements or retirement funds (401K, IRA or similar accounts)
- Credit card/lines of credit statements
- Certificates of deposit
- Investment documents and other non-liquid funds such as stocks, bonds, term deposits, life insurance, auto/property deeds
- Solvency and opinion statement such as a bank letter that verifies "sufficient financial resources" is not acceptable form of financial support
