

Academic Achievement Scholarship Day Undergraduate 2020-2021

Candidate must be a current full-time student, in good standing behaviorally and academically. You must have a 3.5 GPA or higher and have completed at least two full semesters at Lynn. Priority is given to students who will be juniors and seniors during the 2020-21 academic year.

The award cannot exceed \$5,000 per academic year. One half will be disbursed in September and the second half in February. Priority consideration of awards will be given to students who are not receiving any institutional scholarships or who are receiving less than \$10,000 for the academic year.

Interested students must complete the scholarship application. Submit a current resume and an essay that includes:

- An opening paragraph stating your program of study, academic standing, GPA, any honors and your anticipated graduation year.
- A paragraph summarizing your financial need (include any other financial aid you are currently receiving).
- A paragraph clarifying how the financial difficulties impact other areas of your life.
- A closing paragraph explaining how completion of your specific degree will enhance your work life/career.
